TAKING COVID-19 TESTING TO A **NEW LEVEL**

Designed to Restore Confidence in Daily Life

The revolutionary NAVICA™ app helps people navigate daily life in a new normal. NAVICA displays results from the 15-minute Abbott BinaxNOW™ COVID-19 Ag Card, an antigen rapid test, to help individuals make informed decisions.

This first-of-its-kind app, available at no charge, allows people who test negative to get an encrypted temporary digital NAVICA Pass, similar to an airline boarding pass. NAVICA-enabled organizations will be able to verify an individual's negative COVID-19 test result by scanning the individual's digital NAVICA Pass to facilitate entry into facilities, along with hand-washing, social distancing, enhanced cleaning and mask-wearing.



Your Role in the NAVICA Process

As a NAVICA-enabled test site, you will use the NAVICA Administrator app to communicate encrypted BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card test results to participants and allow them to obtain a digital NAVICA Pass with a negative test result. To conduct testing at your site, a CLIA-waived license is required per the FDA Emergency Use Authorization for BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card.



As a BinaxNOW™ COVID-19 Ag Card testing site, you play an important role in helping people move about with greater confidence.


THE NAVICA™-BinaxNOW TESTING PROCESS IS SIMPLE:

- 1 Scan the participant's NAVICA ID on their mobile device and verify photo ID match.
- 2 Scan the unique QR code on the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card to create a secure link between the participant and the test card.
- 3 Perform the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card test, following the package insert instructions.

- Rescan the QR code on the test card to confirm the link and chain of custody between the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card test and the participant.
- 5 Visually interpret the test result on the card and submit the positive or negative result accordingly via the NAVICA app.

The participant will be notified of their result submission through the NAVICA app. A negative result submission will generate an encrypted digital NAVICA Pass as a QR code on the individual's mobile device. If the participant tests positive, they will receive a NAVICA message to follow CDC Guidelines on quarantine and consult their healthcare provider.

Abbott believes the NAVICA app and BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card test will help us recover a bit more freedom, confidence and normalcy in our everyday lives.







Rotate the nasal swab shaft three times



ORDER YOUR TEST

United's Travel-Ready Center gives you the option to purchase Abbott's BinaxNOW Home Tests through eMed, which will be shipped to you before your flight.



PACK YOUR TEST IN YOUR CARRY-ON

Passengers receive the tests in the mail and pack the unopened tests in their carry-on bag.



CONDUCT THE TEST BEFORE YOUR FLIGHT HOME

No more than three days before departing, the traveler logs into eMed where a live certified guide walks you through the testing process.



GET YOUR NAVICA DIGITAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE

If test results are negative, eMed will send a digital health certificate through the NAVICA app. If a test result is positive or inconclusive, United's Travel-Ready Center can help the passenger with additional information.

The BinaxNOW™ COVID-19 Ag Card Home Test is a lateral flow immunoassay intended for the qualitative detection of nucleocapsid protein antigen from SARS-CoV-2. This test is authorized for prescription home use with self-collected observed direct anterior nasal (nares) swab samples from individuals aged 15 years or older who are suspected of COVID-19 by their healthcare provider within the first seven days of symptom onset or adult collected nasal swab samples from individuals aged four years or older who are suspected of COVID-19 by their healthcare provider within the first seven days of symptom onset.

The BinaxNOW COVID-19 Ag Card Home Test is to be performed only with the supervision of a telehealth proctor.

gather in the U.S. are grappling with decisions about whether to open and how broadly to do so, as cases of COVID-19 continue rising in parts of the country. If only there were an easy way to identify people who have tested negative for the virus.

Good news - now there is.

Abbott's new rapid antigen test — the BinaxNOW[™] COVID-19 Ag Card — has received emergency use authorization (EUA) from the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA). The test pairs with an optional app called NAVICA[™] that works like a secure mobile boarding pass, which can be scanned to facilitate

easier entry into organizations and facilities.

Chris Scoggins, Abbott's senior vice president, Rapid Diagnostics, answers the five most pressing questions about this first-of-its-kind app that will be available at no charge.

Check it out:

1. What is the NAVICA App?

This is a new app that Abbott designed to pair with our BinaxNOW rapid antigen test for COVID-19. The app works on iPhone and Android devices and allows people to store, access and display their BinaxNOW test results so we can more confidently return to life.

2. How Does the App Work?

When you get Abbott's BinaxNOW test at a NAVICA-

only to you and those whom you choose to share them with.

If you test negative, the app will display a temporary encrypted digital pass with a QR code, similar to an airline boarding pass. The pass will be renewed each time a person takes a new test and receives a negative test result and will include the date of the latest test result. Organizations will be able to view and verify the information on a mobile device to facilitate entry into facilities along with hand-washing, social distancing, enhanced cleaning and mask-wearing. If you test positive, you'll receive a message in the app to quarantine and talk to your doctor.

3. What are the Key Benefits of the NAVICA App for Consumers?

It's all about helping restore a sense of normalcy. Helping people get back to doing the things they love with a little more confidence than they've had during the pandemic.

...for Healthcare Providers?

Many frontline health workers are overwhelmed with people who need to be tested or treated for COVID-19. The NAVICA app allows healthcare providers in all settings to easily display test results to their patients and customers.

...for Organizations like Employers, Schools and Other Places Where People Gather?

results of our BinaxNOW test, may help reduce the risk of virus spread and increase confidence at places where people tend to gather in large numbers.

4. Where can People Get the App?

The NAVICA app can be downloaded for no charge in the U.S. from the App Store [Apple devices] and the Google Play Store [Android devices]. After downloading the app, you just enter some basic information. The whole process takes about two minutes.

5. How is Abbott Protecting the Security of Personal Information in the App?

Maintaining customers' privacy is always a priority for Abbott. When it comes to the NAVICA app, the data transmitted are encrypted. And users only share their first and last name, email address, phone number, zip code, and date of birth, which limits the sensitive identifying data being shared in the first place. Additionally, the app isn't used for contact tracing, so personal location information is not being tracked or shared.



When Wallace Abbott first opened the doors to his pharmacy in Chicago's Ravenswood neighborhood, Illinois was one of 38 United States.

"It could be used by healthcare professionals in a variety of locations such as schools and workplaces," said Abbott President and CEO Robert Ford in accepting the award on behalf of the company. "And BinaxNOW pairs with our complementary mobile app NAVICA, which displays users' test results. With this combined solution, a person's COVID status can be quickly verified to provide confidence in accessing common gathering places."

And it's why BinaxNOW and NAVICA were among those honored by the Chicago Innovation Awards.

This year's award marks the 11th in the Chicago Innovation Awards' 19 years that Abbott has been recognized, the most by any company.
